<b>EDUCATORS FOR MAINE PROGRAM</b> This is a competitive, merit-based, <b>forgivable loan program (\$3,000 annually, \$12,000 total)</b> for Maine students (pursuing careers in teaching, including speech pathology and child development or childcare. Recipients must intend to work in Maine after completing their education and cannot currently hold state certification to teach or child care provider qualifications, as applicable. <b>STATE OF MAINE GRANT PROGRAM</b> This is a need-based program that provides grants to undergraduate students in varying amounts depending upon the type of institution you attend and your enrollment status. The annual amounts range from \$250 to \$1,250. You must file the FAFSA by May 1 each year you plan to attend college. The college/university you attend will review your information and determine if you are eligible each year.
